



Dues & Fees

Membership Dues

The financial support of *all* our members assures the United Jewish Center’s future. Your support enables us to continue the programs and activities that make our synagogue the vital place that it is today.

1. Annual Membership Dues

UJC membership dues are based on the categories described below. These amounts are the minimum required to enable the UJC to meet its financial obligations.

**Defined as 2 adults, with or without dependent children. Households with one adult and dependent children pay the “single” rate.*

NOTE: Members who join between July 1 and December 31 pay 50% of the regular annual rate from date of joining until the end of the calendar year. The regular dues rate applies after January 1 of the following year.

2. Capital Fund for New Members

New members of the United Jewish Center are asked to pay the following capital fund amounts, spread out over five years in equal annual payments. Family membership units are asked to pay \$1,800 (total) and single membership units are asked to pay \$900 (total). The first payment is due by the end of the first year of membership. *Example:* A family between the ages of 30 and 70 would owe \$360.00 at the end of each of their first five years of membership

3. Annual “Be A Blessing” Contribution

Since the UJC has a flat fee (not a “fair share”) dues structure, we ask members who are financially able to contribute more than their dues to participate in this program. Your additional support means that we never have to turn away members with financial hardship.

4. Special Consideration

Members facing financial hardship may apply for special consideration (dues lowered for the current year). This process is confidential; you may request the form from our office.
